

As a Minds Matter mentor, you will have the chance to impact a young student's life, working closely together through each stage of their college-bound journey.

### **About Mentoring:**

You will be paired with one student alongside a second co-mentor (2:1).

You'll be part of a community of 400+ other mentors.

No prior experience required.

Sessions are held on Saturdays from 11:00 AM - 1:00 PM at MIT and BU.

There are approximately 25 sessions September-June, and mentors are expected to attend 80% of those sessions.

Mentors should be a consistent positive influence for each student throughout their three-year experience; for this reason we ask that you make a minimum two-year commitment to the program.

#### **How to Apply:**

Our program year kicks off in the fall; for this reason, mentor recruitment typically takes place in the preceding spring/summer season.

We strongly encourage individuals who share those identities to apply.
